Summer Samba is a tribute show honoring Brazil's, Antonio Carlos Jobim, one of the most important songwriters of the 20th century. He was a primary force behind the 'bossa nova' or 'new style' of music and his songs have been performed by many singers and instrumentalists within Brazil and internationally. Perhaps most widely known as the composer of "The Girl from Ipanema", Jobim left us a repertoire of songs that are now considered jazz standards, not to mention influencing composers' style for generations to come. Annie Kozuch – Vocalist

International actress and vocalist, Annie Kozuch spent 20 years in Mexico City has been performing throughout the United States and Japan with symphonies, bands and trios. Ten years ago she teamed up with jazz pianist, composer, Frank Ponzio and together they have performed in New York City (Park Avenue's Feinstein's at the Lowes Regency, The Metropolitan Room, Stage 72 at The Triad, The Laurie Beechman Theatre, The West End Lounge, Somethin' Jazz, to name a few), throughout Long Island and New Jersey and the Natchez Jazz Festival in Mississippi.

Her first CD, Here with You (2010), peaked at No. 6 on the CMJ charts and her most current, Mostly Jobim (2013), landed No. 19 on the same charts. Whether performing as a duo, trio, quartet or a full orchestra, Kozuch delights her audience performing an array of standards from the American Songbook (think Frank Sinatra and Ella Fitzgerald) adding Mexican love songs from Ms. Kozuch's adopted homeland ("It's Impossible") with recent interpretations from her latest CD with Brazil's 'king of bossa nova', Antonio Carlos Jobim ("Girl from Ipanema").

Frank Ponzio, jazz pianist and composer has performed with David Amram, Ben Vereen, Phil Donahue, Joe Beck, Nancy LaMott, Bob McGrath of Sesame Street and Aisha Morris (Stevie Wonder's daughter) at Birdland, Carnegie Hall and Town Hall. Original films scores include The Silver Swing, directed by Martha Parker, the feature film A Level Field, Ken Haywood and Midnight to Midnight, Roberta Berman.

He has enjoyed a fifteen year-long association with the Jacques d'Amboise's *National Dance Institute*. He was their full-time music director for several years. For 3 years he was a vocal coach at Jim Lipton's *New School's Actors Studio*.
